Chocolate No Bake Cookies

- 2 Cups Sugar
- 4 T. Cocoa
- 1 stick oleo
- ½ cup milk
- 3 cups oats(minute)
- ½ cup Peanut Butter
- ½ t. Vanilla

Combine sugar, cocoa, oleo, and milk in a sauce pan. Bring to a boil and continue to boil for 1.5 minutes. Combine Oats peanut butter and vanilla in a bowl. Pour hot mixture over ingredients in bowl. Drop by teaspoonful on waxed paper. Eat when cured to desired hardness.
